The Tarrangower community comprises all residents, businesses and property owners in the Tarrangower Ward of Mount Alexander Shire, including Maldon, Baringhup, Nuggetty and Walmer (Western part).

WHAT IS A COMMUNITY PLAN?

Community planning is participatory. It is a shared vision for the community created by the community. It considers social, cultural, economic, environmental and infrastructure areas that impact our quality of life in this community.

The Tarrangower Tomorrow Community Plan will seek to balance priorities and goals between topic areas. Action plans for each of the topic areas, formulated by interested community members and groups, will provide a road map for steering community change by identifying what will be done, who will do it, and how it will be done.

The community owns the Tarrangower Tomorrow Community Plan. Achievement of its vision, goals and actions is dependent on our collective wisdom and intelligence, collaboration and commitment. The plan will also communicate agreed goals to other players who impact what happens in our area like local or state government.

STEPS IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE COMMUNITY PLAN.

The community planning steering committee formed in mid 2019, following the completion and evaluation of Maldon's previous 2015 Community Plan. The committee is in the process of involving the community in developing a new Tarrangower Community Plan –Tarrangower Tomorrow.

MALDON STREETScape PROJECT.

The works currently planned and being undertaken for the Maldon Streetscape project are largely initiated from previous community plans, being undertaken as a measure of the success of earlier community activities. Consequently, streetscape works do not directly form part of the Tarrangower Tomorrow planning.

Since the community consultations for the Tarrangower Tomorrow Plan were undertaken, the COVID 19 pandemic has intervened resulting in some serious social and economic impacts. It is acknowledged that COVID 19 may influence and change our priorities and implementation strategies.
